



Communities in Action: Urban Sustainability & Engagement

The Faculty of Social Studies at the University of Ostrava is organizing a **Blended Intensive Programme (BIP)** focused on **community work and sustainable development**. The programme combines expert lectures, thematic discussions with professionals from the field, and a hands-on component through **mini-projects implemented directly within the community in Jílová Street, Ostrava**.

Building on the success of previous BIP activities in 2023 and 2024, this year's programme offers international students the opportunity to **actively participate in the Czech Sustainable Development Week**. Students will engage in real-life projects that foster collaboration with the local community and address pressing environmental and social challenges.

Key thematic areas include:

- Community work in practice
- Urban gardening
- Organizing events for children and the public
- · Sustainability in urban space

Participants will collaborate with a local school, contribute to the preparation of a community event at a newly developed children's playground, and take part in activities aimed at improving the local public space.

Programme format:

- Online sessions: 16 and 23 September 2025
- On-site activities in Ostrava: 28 September 3 October 2025 (including team building, project work, and a final presentation)

This BIP provides a platform for sharing experiences, developing intercultural competencies, and exploring innovative approaches to improving everyday life in urban communities.
